

1. Devoted to Prayer

Start off with feedback from Sunday's message. What did those that were there - or those that have caught up online - take away from it? What encouraged them, what informed them and what challenged them?

Read Acts 2.41-47

⁴² They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.

Getting Started with Prayer

- How do you find prayer? It is something that's easy for you?
- What kinds of things do you find yourself praying about?

Being an outward focused community:

Chloe talked about how the early church was 'outward focused' right from the beginning, existing for the sake of those not part of the community as much as for those who were part of this early church.

- How do you think at metro we are being outward focussed in what we do?
- As a church, how could we be better at this?
- What could we do as a hub to be outward focussed?

Praying for others:

- As part of being 'outward focused', why do you think that we should be praying for other people?
- We'd like to be a community 'devoted to prayer' for others what are the challenges that we face?
- Chloe talked about intercession, praying for others, being part of our role as Christians, is this something you have considered before? How does it make you feel?

Adopting a rhythm:

It can be hard to remember to pray and we can't rely on feeling like it. The early church adopted rhythms of prayer to help them stay devoted to it.

 What are ways of praying/ rhythms of prayer that have worked for you? Do you have any ideas of other rhythms of prayer that might work well? What rhythm are you going to put into place this week to help you pray for others?
