- These are the last words Jesus speaks to his disciples on earth. What do you think they show us about the character of God and his vision for humanity?
- How does big vision make you feel? (Jesus' big vision of us going to the 'ends of the earth' and Philip's big vision of planting 64 churches in 10 years)
- What do you feel like Jesus is calling you to do this year? What do you want to commit to, both in church and in your personal faith?

Take some time to pray together – for each other, for your Hub and for Metro.

(The start of the year is a really good time to set the tone for prayer, and show how much we value it, so let's make sure we create lots of time for this)
