Discussion Questions

- Why do you think a community that looked like that was so attractive to the world?
- What do you think it was about Jesus, and following him, that made people do community in this way?
- How could we make our Hub look more like this community in Acts 2?
- Go round the group and ask each person to share what their hopes are for Hub this year.
- Take some time to write up together your vision for your Hub this year what you want the vibe to be, what you want to press into, how you want to have grown by the end etc.

BIG IDEA: Living as a radical community of faith is proof to the world that the gospel message is true. It's what the missing generation needs to be convinced of Christianity.

Pray Together

Lift your vision for your Hub to God and ask him to help you fulfil it this year.
