The Two Sisters

Read Luke 10.38-42

- Reading the passage, what stands out to you?
- Susanna talked about this passage being all about what defines us. If you were being honest, what things define you the most in your life?
 Where do you get your sense of identity from the most?
- Martha defined herself by the role life had dealt her, whereas Mary defined herself by being a disciple of Jesus. Which one do you identify the most with?
- What are some of the distractions in our lives that can divide our attention from Jesus?
- In this story, Jesus wants Martha and Mary's attention, what does this say about Jesus, both in that culture and today?
- What would you say you pay the most attention to? How do you think this shapes you?
- What does it look like for you to give Jesus your attention? Do you have a time and a space with Jesus? How do you connect with Him without distractions?

BIG IDEA: We are defined by what we pay attention to. In a world competing for our attention, when we practise giving Jesus our full attention, his presence defines and shapes us.

Pray that we would be giving Jesus our full attention, and that Jesus would be the one to totally define us.
